Buoys can either be polystyrene or plastic foam filled (minimum of 300mm diameter to a maximum of 500mm). Alternatively a 200mm manufactured stick buoy will be accepted.
	Chain : As per contractors specifications.
	Weights : No ground weights permitted.

Tender Arrangements	Tenders (that service larger vessels on swing moorings), that are moored in shallow water or at an approved non-berthing section of a public jetty, are required to show the identification of the registered vessel on the outside structure of the tender vessel.
