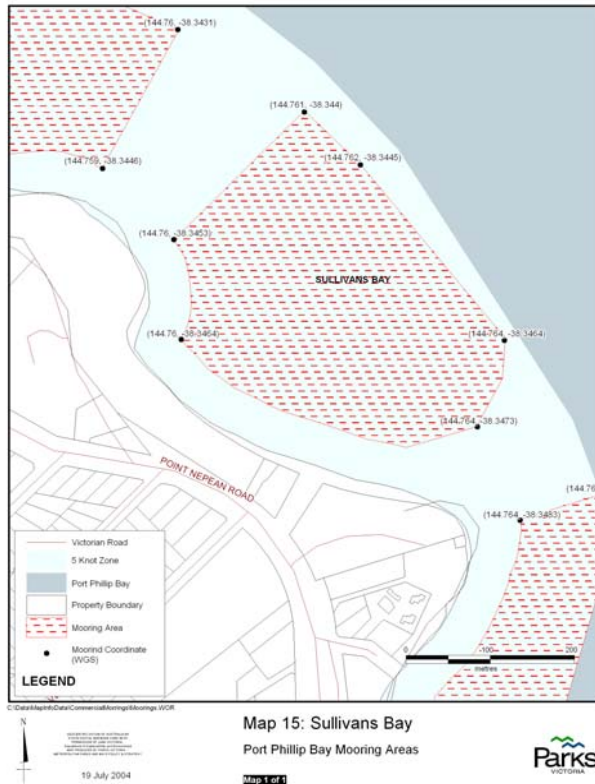

Local Features	Collins Settlement Historic Site – Victoria’s first official settlement 1803. Small sand boat ramp present to the Bays East.
Public Moorings present	NO
Availability of Temporary Moorings	NO
Weather Conditions	Open water exposed to all winds especially those from the north.
Tackle Requirements	Buoys : Identification buoys are to be attached to the mooring at all times and the site identification number must be clearly visible. Buoys can either be polystyrene or plastic foam filled (minimum of 300mm diameter to a maximum of 500mm). Alternatively a 200mm manufactured stick buoy will be accepted.
	Chain : As per contractor’s specifications.
	Weights : No ground weights permitted.

Tender Arrangements	Tenders (that service larger vessels on swing moorings), that are moored in shallow water or at an approved non-berthing section of a public jetty, are required to show the identification of the registered vessel on the outside structure of the tender vessel.
Access	Small car park located at rear of mooring ground otherwise parking is available along Pt Nepean Rd.
