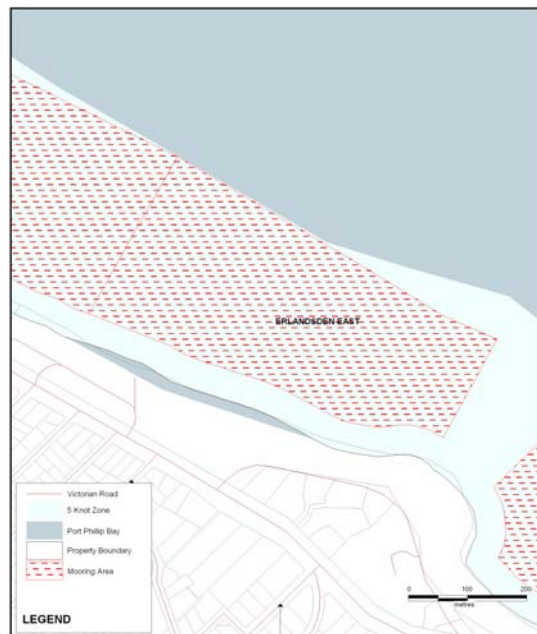

<b>Mooring Location</b>	Erlandsen East
<b>Set Aside Name</b>	Erlandsen East
<b>Melways Reference</b>	Page 157 E9
<b>Boundaries</b>	From a line through Salonika St to the Western point of The Sisters.
<b>Agent Managing</b>	Parks Victoria
<b>Status</b>	Full
<b>Waiting List</b>	NO
<b>Local Features</b>	Sorrento Sailing Club, Foreshore Camping
<b>Public Moorings present</b>	NO
<b>Availability of Temporary Moorings</b>	NO
<b>Weather Conditions</b>	Open Waters.
<b>Tackle Requirements</b>	<p><b>Buoys</b> : Identification buoys are to be attached to the mooring at all times and the site identification number must be clearly visible. Buoys can either be polystyrene or plastic foam filled (minimum of 300mm diameter to a maximum of 500mm). Alternatively a 200mm manufactured stick buoy will be accepted.</p> <p><b>Chain</b> : As per contractors specifications</p> <p><b>Weights</b> : No ground weights permitted.</p>
<b>Tender Arrangements</b>	Tenders (that service larger vessels on swing moorings), that are moored in shallow water or at an approved non-berthing section of a public jetty, are required to show the identification of the registered vessel on the outside structure of the tender vessel.

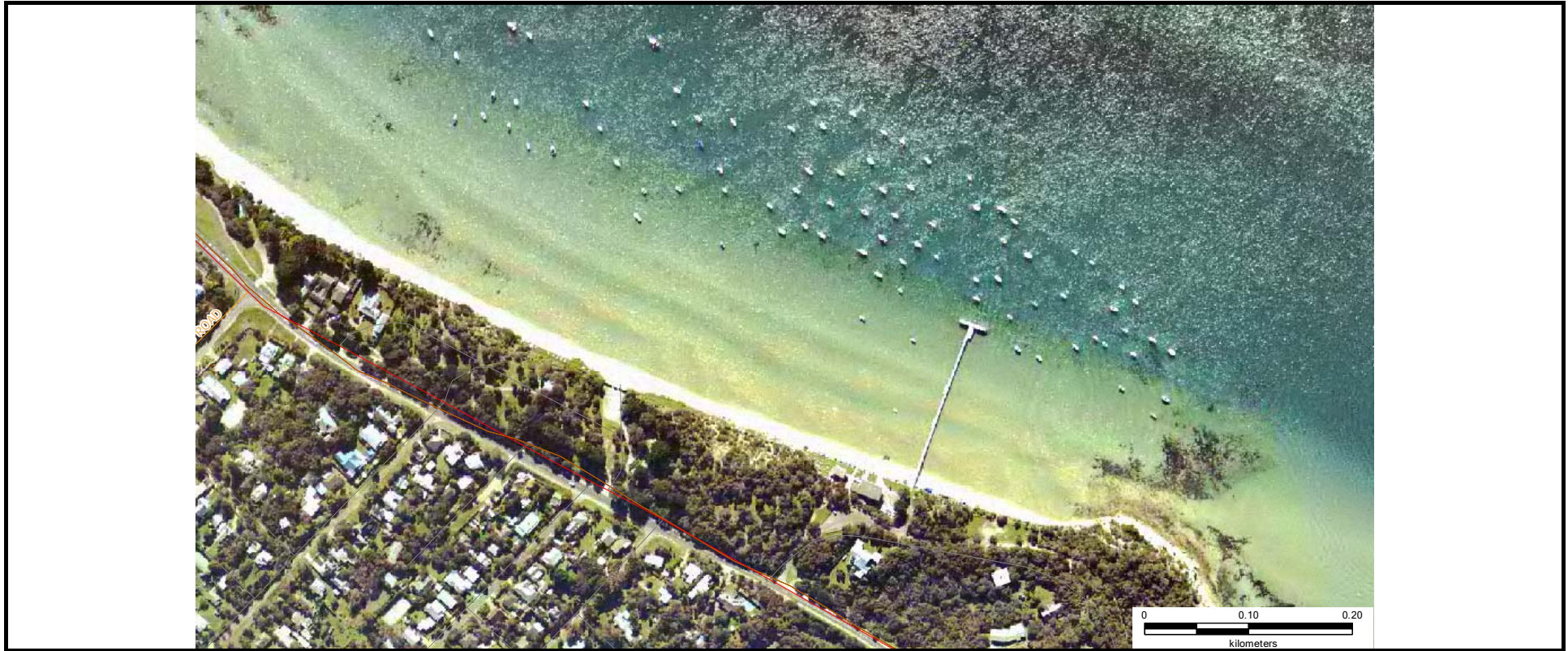
<b>Access</b>	Small car park located at rear of mooring ground otherwise parking is available along Pt Nepean Rd.
