

# Wilsons Promontory National Park



## Tidal River Accommodation and Camping Guide

Wilsons Promontory National Park offers a wide range of roofed accommodation including cabins, units, huts, and group lodges. Ask about our new wilderness retreats, contemporary safari-style tents located in a tranquil corner of Tidal River. Tidal River is also the main camping location in Wilsons Promontory National Park. All camping facilities are within walking distance of Norman Beach.

### Accommodation options

#### Wilderness retreats

Four tents with built-in ensuites cater for couples, but can accommodate up to four people.

##### Features

- Queen sized bed, single futon chair/bed, single trundle bed
- Small fridge
- Deck and outdoor chairs
- Bed linen, towels
- Crockery, cutlery and cooking utensils
- Communal kitchen with gas hotplate, fridge and microwave
- Gas heating

#### Cabins

Cabins accommodate up to six people and feature natural light and timber deck area for outdoor relaxation. Two cabins with disabled facilities are available.

##### Features

- Spacious living area
- Fully equipped kitchen with microwave and two small fridges
- One bedroom with queen sized bed and one bedroom with two bunk beds
- Linen and towels are provided
- Bathroom, most with a bath tub
- Gas heating

The Visitor Centre at Tidal River provides information about the many things to do at Wilsons Promontory.

Facilities and services at Tidal River include a store, café, petrol and gas bottle refill, ice and an outdoor cinema (seasonal).

#### Lorikeet units

Sleep up to four people in fully self-contained motel style accommodation.

##### Features

- Fully equipped kitchen (full size fridge, no microwave)
- Two single beds in the bedroom and a king sized bed in the living area that can be split and made into two single beds
- Linen and towels are provided
- Bathroom
- Central dining/living area
- Gas heating

#### Huts

These one room huts accommodate either four or six people in bunk beds. Guests provide their own linen, blankets, pillow and towels, and make use of the nearby campground amenities.

##### Features

- 4 burner stove with oven/grill
- Small fridge
- Sink with cold water
- Crockery, cutlery and cooking utensils
- Linen and towel hire is available on request
- Gas heating

#### Group lodges

Perfect for schools, family groups, clubs and tour groups. Lodges can accommodate groups of 12, 24 or 30 people.

##### Features

- Central dining/living area
- Fully equipped kitchen, with microwave
- Blankets and pillows supplied
- Linen and towel hire is available on request
- Bathrooms (some with disabled facilities)
- Gas heating and BBQ

## Accommodation bookings and information

- Accommodation can be booked up to 12 months in advance from the date of arrival, excluding the Christmas/January ballot period.
- Throughout the year minimum night stays apply.
- Check-in time for wilderness retreats, cabins, units and huts is 2.00 pm. Check-out is by 10.00 am.
- Check-in time for group lodges is 4.00 pm. Check-out is by 12 noon.
- Full fees are required at the time of booking. Cancellation fees apply (see below).
- All bookings and payments are non-transferable.
- Group bookings can be made and paid for by one person, provided that at the time the booking is made, each retreat/cabin/hut/ lodge/unit has the contact details of a person who is staying in the accommodation.
- Parks Victoria does not accept any responsibility for damage or loss of property during your stay.
- Guests are advised to make their own travel insurance arrangements.
- All accommodation is non-smoking.

## Camping

The Tidal River camping area has 484 sites and is situated close to beautiful Norman Bay. 20 of these sites are powered. Generators and fires, including solid fuel heating compounds, are not permitted. A dump point for caravan sewage is available. Maps are available at the Tidal River Visitor Centre.

Campground facilities include modern amenity blocks with hot showers, toilets and laundry facilities. Picnic areas are equipped with gas barbeques.

The maximum number of people per site, including children, is eight.

All camping equipment, vehicles, trailers and boats must be parked on your site and must not block road access or damage vegetation.

Campsites can be pre-booked throughout the year with the exception of long weekends and the Christmas ballot (see below). Please call **13 1963** or **03 5680 9555** for further information.

## Long weekends (camping only)

Campsites for the following long weekends can only be obtained by application.

- Melbourne Cup weekend
- Labour Day weekend
- Easter

Pre-booking campsites for the remainder of the year is recommended.

## Christmas ballot

Accommodation and camping at Tidal River is allocated using a ballot system for the peak Christmas holiday season. For further information please check the website:

## Wildlife

Visitors feeding wildlife, especially wombats and rosellas in Tidal River, have created serious park management issues.

Campers have had their tents destroyed by wombats searching for 'people food'. Campers are encouraged to store all food in vehicles or strong boxes. Do not leave food scraps around campsites.

Feeding wildlife is not only bad for their health - it could also be bad for your pocket as a penalty applies.

**Please do not feed any wildlife.**
